Dear Director Prof. Favia,

On behalf of ECOVE, who met on 29 September 2021, I herewith inform you of the Evaluation result, based on the ESEVT full Visitation to your VEE on 24 – 28 May 2021.

The Committee concluded that the following Major Deficiency had been identified:

1. Non-compliance with Substandard 4.4 because of absence of emergency services for ruminants in the VTH, which is not compensated by an alternative on-call service.

In accordance with the European System of Evaluation of Veterinary Training (ESEVT) and based on the educational requirements of the Directive 2005/36/EC as amended by Directive 2013/55/EU,

CONDITIONAL ACCREDITATION**


In line with our agreement, please publish the SER and the Final Visitation Report on your website.

In accordance with the ESEVT SOP 2019, under which the Visitation was completed, a Re-visitiation may be organised as soon as you believe that the Major Deficiency has been corrected and an ongoing process is in place to correct the Minor ones (listed in detail in the Final Visitation Report). Please note that the Re-visitiation must be performed 3 years after the previous Visitation at the latest and can only be performed once; if this interval is exceeded, only a full Visitation can be planned.
